

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, REJECT, ALTER OR TERMINATE A GRANT FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION (CJD) OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG) FOR THE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM FOR PASS-THROUGH TO LOCALS FOR THE FY 2016 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF TO ADMINISTER THE GRANT, AND PLEDGING THAT THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE WILL COMPLY WITH THE GRANT REQUIREMENTS OF THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION (CJD) OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR (OOG).

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Division (CJD), Office of the Governor (OOG) is accepting applications for the Justice Assistance Grant Program for Pass-Through to Locals for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program for state FY 2016. The purpose areas of the Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Formula Grant (JAG) Program are to reduce crime and make improvements to the criminal justice system. Preference will be given to projects that support one or more of the following areas: crime data, trafficking, innovative or evidence based programs, mental health and system improvements.

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove, in the State of Texas, is qualified to apply for grant funds under the Request for Applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the City Manager is designated as the authorized official for the grant and given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant and such funding awarded by the Criminal Justice Division (CJD) Office of the Governor (OOG) for the FY 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program. No matching funds are required.

SECTION 2.

That the City Manager will act on behalf of the City of Copperas Cove and the Copperas Cove Police Department in all matters related to the grant application and any

subsequent grant contract and grant project that may result, and the City Manager will act on the City's behalf in administering the grant.

SECTION 3.

That the City of Copperas Cove will comply with the grant requirements of the Criminal Justice Division (CJD) Office of the Governor (OOG) FY 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program and the State of Texas.


SECTION 4.

SECTION 5.




