

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS, TO NAME THE ACCESS ROADS LOCATED ON WEST US HIGHWAY 190 THAT WERE CONSTRUCTED AS PART OF THE COPPERAS COVE BYPASS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove City Council approved a resolution on December 7, 2010, authorizing the execution of an Advanced Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for the construction of the Copperas Cove Bypass; and

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove deposited \$45,400,000 with the Texas Department of Transportation for the project; and

WHEREAS, the project construction bids for the Copperas Cove Bypass project were opened on May 4, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the low bid was awarded to James Construction by the Texas Department of Transportation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City accepted the project plans prior to the bid letting process that included two streets to be dedicated and maintained by the City upon project completion; and

WHEREAS, Section 311.001 of the Texas Transportation Code grants municipalities the exclusive control over and under the public highways, streets and alleys of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Copperas Cove recommends naming the access roads constructed as part of the Copperas Cove Bypass project along West US Highway 190 in accordance with the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Copperas Cove finds the naming of the access roads is necessary to help eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency response and access and the ability of the public to locate streets and roads within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove finds the naming to be consistent with the overall plans for street naming, addressing and the 911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS:

Section 1.

The City of Copperas Cove names the access roads constructed as part of the Copperas Cove Bypass project and located along West US Highway 190 as presented in the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2.

The City of Copperas Cove City Secretary will provide a copy of this resolution to the Copperas Cove Police Department and the Central Texas Council of Governments for the completion of 911 addressing.




Exhibit A
