

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS, ALLOWING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR A FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY GRANT THROUGH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, TO PURCHASE FIRE INVESTIGATIVE EQUIPMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,928.00.

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security provides opportunities to apply for and receive funding to purchase equipment for fire prevention and fire investigations; and

WHEREAS, the Copperas Cove Fire Department Fire Chief has identified the department needs to include advanced interview recording equipment, respiratory equipment, and digital cameras; and

WHEREAS, Fire Prevention and Fire Investigation activities are designed to reach high risk target groups and mitigate the incidence of death and injuries caused by fire and fire-related hazards; and


WHEREAS, the City Council supports the submittal of Copperas Cove Fire Department's grant application to the Department of Homeland Security

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS THAT:

The members of the Governing Body of the City of Copperas Cove, Texas hereby authorize the City to make application to the Fire Prevention and Safety Grant program to hire one (1) Fire Investigator/Fire Inspector and purchase associated equipment not to exceed \$12,928.00
