

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) NOMINATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AUTHORIZING MATCHING FUNDS; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove feels an obligation to provide citizens safer and ADA compliant facilities to traverse the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove recognizes pedestrians are exposed to dangerous routes along FM 116 from US 190 south to FM 3046 to the Martin Walker Elementary School and park where there is a lack of contiguous sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the need for improvements routes along FM 116 from US 190 south to FM 3046 to the Martin Walker Elementary School and park and to allow for avenues to achieve the improvements of community facilities along this route; and

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove wishes to apply for funding through the Texas Department of Transportation-Transportation Alternatives Program project nomination in order to obtain funds for this project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE,

SECTION 1.

The City of Copperas Cove supports the submission of the nomination for this project as described in the TAP 2015 Nomination Form through the Texas Department of Transportation-Transportation Alternatives Program for funding that will provide improvements routes along FM 116 from US 190 south to FM 3046 to the Martin Walker Elementary School and park, enhancing the City's community facilities by making them safer and ADA compliant.

SECTION 2.

The City of Copperas Cove pledges to support a nomination requesting federal funding for assistance by the City of Copperas Cove in the amount of \$533,928.00; and

SECTION 3.

The City of Copperas Cove will provide a match of 20% for the construction of the project described in the TAP 2015 Nomination Form; and

SECTION 4.

The Project Sponsor supports funding this project as described in the TAP 2015 Nomination Form (including the construction budget, the department's 15% administrative costs, and the required local match) and is willing to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management, and financing. The project sponsor is willing and able to enter into an agreement with the department by resolution or ordinance should the project receive TAP funding.


SECTION 5.

SECTION 6.


