

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-22

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS RESCINDING
STAGE 1 WATER RESTRICTIONS.**


- WHEREAS,** Bell County Water Control and Improvement District (BCWCID) No. 1 operates a water treatment facility located on Lake Belton that supplies potable water to the City of Copperas Cove; and
- WHEREAS,** BCWCID No. 1 purchases a supply of water from the Brazos River Authority (BRA); and
- WHEREAS,** The combined reservoir storage capacity has prompted BRA to rescind a Stage 1 Mandatory Restriction for reservoirs in the Brazos River system, including Lake Belton; and
- WHEREAS,** BRA has informed all customers that a Stage 1 Mandatory reduction in water use and drought contingency plans should be rescinded; and
- WHEREAS,** Stage 1 of the City of Copperas Cove Drought Contingency Plan defines specific conservation measures for customers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS:


Section 1.

That the City of Copperas Cove is rescinding STAGE 1 water restrictions effective June 3, 2015. STAGE 1 water restrictions have been in effect since January 4, 2013. Brazos River Basin reservoirs are replenished and require no water use restrictions.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED on this 2nd day of June 2015 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Copperas Cove, Texas which meeting was held in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, *Tex. Gov't Code*, §551.001, et.seq. at which meeting a quorum was present and voting.


