

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS, TO CERTIFY LOCAL FUNDING AND SUPPORT OF THE DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION SIDEWALK PROJECT TO THE KILLEEN-TEMPLE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR FUNDING COMPETITION TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2015/2016 FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION MOVING AHEAD FOR PROGRESS IN THE 21ST CENTURY (MAP-21) SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM METROPOLITAN MOBILITY-CATEGORY 7

WHEREAS, the Killeen-Temple Metropolitan Planning Organization issued a call for nomination for communities to apply for Federal Highway Administration funding assistance made available through the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21) Surface Transportation Program Metropolitan Mobility-Category 7 (FYs 15/16);

WHEREAS, the Copperas Cove Downtown Streetscape project will provide improved access and safety for pedestrians to travel the downtown area;

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove proposes to submit a nomination requesting federal funding for assistance in the amount of \$219,021.87; and

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove will provide a match totaling \$35,591.05 which includes 10% match of the Total Construction Cost plus a required 3% TxDOT Administrative Fee. The Copperas Cove Economic Development Corporation will provide a 10% match of the Total Construction Cost in the amount of \$27,377.74. The total match for the project application is \$62,968.79.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

The City of Copperas Cove supports funding this project as shown in the nomination budget and commits to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management, and financing. The City is willing and able to enter into an agreement with TxDOT by resolution or ordinance.

SECTION 2.

That the City adopts resolution 2015-41 approving the submission of the project nomination; and the support and funding of the project should it receive federal funds.

SECTION 3.

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City in all matters relating to this funding nomination and to execute all necessary applications, assurances, certifications, and other documents, relative to the submission, later acceptance, and administration of such funds.

SECTION 4.

That it is hereby officially found and determined that this meeting at which this resolution is passed is open to the public as required by law, and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED on this 20th day of October, 2015, at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Copperas Cove, Texas, which meeting was held in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, *Tex. Gov't. Code, §551.001, et.seq.* at which meeting a quorum was present and voting.






