**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS,  
SUPPORTING THE DEDICATION OF THE NEWLY  
CONSTRUCTED FIRE STATION 2 IN HONOR OF JOHN A. HULL.**

**WHEREAS,** John A. Hull was born on February 1, 1933 in what was formerly known as Antelope, Texas, to A.T. and Johnnie Hull, and the Hull Family later moved into Copperas Cove in 1941 when their property was purchased by Camp Hood; and

**WHEREAS,** John A. Hull attended school in Copperas Cove, graduated in 1950, and went on to study accounting at Draughon's Business College in Dallas, Texas from 1950 to 1952; and

**WHEREAS,** John A. Hull returned to Copperas Cove and married his sweetheart Shirley Ann Dionne Fritz on July 26, 1952, and they shared the experience of raising three successful children, Johnny, Lonnie and Linda; and

**WHEREAS,** John A. Hull spent 28 years of his life working as a civilian contract photographer on Fort Hood and approximately 20 years serving as a volunteer firefighter for the Copperas Cove Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS,** John A. Hull has spent a lifetime serving the citizens of the community as the State Council of Governments President, as the State President of the Reserve Conservation District, as a Coryell County Commissioner from 1983 to 1991, as the Coryell County Judge from 1991-2003, as a Coryell County School Board Member for 4 years, as a Copperas Cove ISD Board Member for 20 years, as a City of Copperas Cove Councilman for 3 years and Mayor for 2 ½ terms, and service to many more civic organizations and committees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS:** that the newly constructed Fire Station 2, located at 2401 West FM 1113, Copperas Cove, Texas be named in honor of John A. Hull.
