

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN ADVANCED FUNDING AGREEMENT AND LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR LANDSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS ALONG BUSINESS 190 AT CONSTITUTION WEST TO DEWALD STREET AND AGREEING TO PROVIDE MAINTENANCE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE JUNE 5, 2013 MUNICIPAL MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE.

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove was awarded \$210,000 in Governor's Community Achievement funds in 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation and the City of Copperas Cove entered into a Municipal Maintenance Agreement on June 5, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City of Copperas Cove submitted a landscape improvement project along Business 190 from Constitution west to Dewald Street to the Texas Department of Transportation and received approval; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Texas Department of Transportation agree to initiate the bid letting process for the project in March 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City assumes financial responsibility for authorized project overruns (project costs in excess of \$210,000); and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation and the City agree that the project will enhance the movement of traffic in this rapidly growing area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS:

Section 1.

The City Council directs and designates the City Manager as the City's Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with the Advanced Funding Agreement and Landscape Maintenance Agreement along with the City's participation in the project.

Section 2.

The City of Copperas Cove agrees to submit payment to the Texas Department of Transportation for any project costs above the amount of \$210,000 and any overruns associated with project construction.
