

## RESOLUTION NO. 2016-25

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS IMPLEMENTING STAGE 4 WATER RESTRICTIONS.

- WHEREAS,** The City Council approved an Advanced Funding Agreement on June 16, 2015 with the Texas Department of Transportation for the utility relocations required as a result of the State's FM 116 Road Widening project; and
- WHEREAS,** The City was notified by the Texas Department of Transportation that the City's existing 18-inch water transmission line from Turkey Run to Hogg Mountain was in direct conflict with the proposed storm drain piping included in the State's project; and
- WHEREAS,** The City will be relocating the transmission line and must remove that line from service to complete the relocation; and
- WHEREAS,** The offline period for the line is planned to occur during the upcoming summer, which is typically a high irrigation demand time; and
- WHEREAS,** The City Council approved Ordinance 2015-09, amending the City's Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plan; and
- WHEREAS,** The Plan provides for Stage 4 Water Restrictions to be implemented during emergency water shortage conditions; and
- WHEREAS,** The City of Copperas Cove will provide notice to all residents and business owners of the need for water restrictions during the period the line is being relocated.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS:**

#### **Section 1.**

That the City of Copperas Cove is instituting STAGE 4 water restrictions effective on June 8, 2016. STAGE 4 water restrictions will continue until the water transmission line relocation is completed.

**PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED** on this 7th day of June 2016 at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Copperas Cove, Texas which meeting was held in compliance with the Open Meetings Act, *Tex. Gov't Code*, §551.001, et.seq. at which meeting a quorum was present and voting.


