1. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Copperas Cove High School Special Education Department is having a “Field Week” on the importance of pet care October 16-20, 2013.

2. BACKGROUND/HISTORY

The Special Education students will be making art projects, homemade dog treats, and learning about the importance of taking care of pets as well as themselves. The students will be donating the homemade dog treats to Animal Control.
