Solid Waste – City Wide Spring Clean-Up

Copperas Cove, Texas – The Copperas Cove Solid Waste Department will host the annual City Wide Spring Clean-Up event on Saturday, April 23, 2016 from 8am to 1pm. During this time period, Copperas Cove residents and business owners will be granted two FREE visits per utility account to the Solid Waste Transfer Station, located at 2605 South FM 116, to dispose of household trash and waste. Participants will be required to show proof of residency prior to dumping.

Items that will be accepted are basic household trash and junk, brush and yard waste, appliances, computers, recycling, and used cooking oil. Used tires will also be accepted, however at a rate of \$3 - \$7 per tire and they must be off the rim. Construction debris and household hazardous waste will NOT be accepted during this event. ITEMS THAT WILL BE ACCEPTED: HOUSEHOLD TRASH & JUNK

Brush & Yard Waste: limited to 2 pickup truck loads of brush per resident. Kraft bags only no plastic bags. **NO TRAILER LOADS**

Appliances: freezers, refrigerators, and air conditioners must have the compressor removed.

Computers: Including monitors, computer towers (CPU's), keyboard, mice and printers will be accepted.

Recycling: scrap metal, cardboard to include cereal and soda boxes, aluminum cans, newspaper with the inserts, office paper (including magazines), steel cans, and plastics #1-#7. No plastic bags!

Tires: Must be off the rim and will be charged at \$3/tire up to 17" and \$7/tire over 17"

Cooking Oil: Cooking oil will be accepted. Cooking oil must be verified by Solid Waste personnel.
