Solid Waste – City Wide Spring Clean-Up

Copperas Cove, Texas – The Copperas Cove Solid Waste Department and Keep Copperas Cove Beautiful will host the annual City Wide Spring Clean-Up event on Saturday, April 28, 2018 from 8am to 1pm. During this time period, Copperas Cove residents and business owners will be granted two FREE visits per utility account to the Solid Waste Operational Center, located at 2605 South FM 116, to dispose of household trash and waste. Participants will be required to show proof of residency prior to dumping.

Items that will be accepted are basic household trash and junk, brush and yard waste, appliances, recycling, used cooking oil, etc. Construction debris and household hazardous waste will NOT be accepted during this event. Please review the attached flyer for additional specific information.

Items that will be accepted:

Household Trash & Junk

Brush & Yard Waste: limited to 2 pickup truck loads of brush per resident. Yard waste in Kraft bags only no plastic bags. No trailer loads.

Appliances: freezers, refrigerators, and air conditioners must have the compressor removed.

Computers: including monitors, computer towers (CPU's), keyboard, mice and printers will be accepted for recycling.

Recycling: scrap metal, cardboard to include cereal and soda boxes, aluminum cans, newspaper with the inserts, office paper (including magazines), steel cans, and plastics #1-#7. No plastic bags!

Cooking Oil: Cooking oil will be accepted. Cooking oil must be verified by Solid Waste personnel.

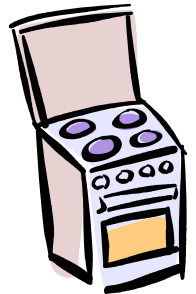
