Temporary Street Closure – Nathan Lane

Copperas Cove, Texas – Due to an on-going Public Works construction project, Nathan Lane will be closed to thru traffic from Bowen Avenue to Risen Star Lane for approximately ten days. The street closure will begin on Wednesday, August 26, 2015, and may extend beyond the ten days if needed. The contractor will mark the area with appropriate signs and motorists are encouraged to travel alternate routes.

Water service interruptions are also possible during this time. Potentially affected customers will receive notice from Water Distribution by way of a notification flyer.

The next phase of the Southeast Water Improvement Project will begin tomorrow, Wednesday, August 26, 2015. Wolfe Construction, contractor for the project, will be working on Nathan Lane and Risen Star Lane installing a 16" waterline. There will be a road closure for through traffic on Nathan Lane starting tomorrow, August 26, 2015, for ten days. Residents are encouraged to find alternate routes during this time.

Like any construction work be prepared for dust, heavy equipment movement, and other inconveniences associated with construction.

Water service interruptions are possible during this time so familiarize yourself with the suggestions below.

THE FOLLOWING ARE SUGGESTIONS TO ASSIST YOU:

1. FILL WATER JUGS OR BUCKETS, ETC. FOR YOUR PERSONAL USE.
2. IF YOUR WATER APPEARS DISCOLORED OR CLOUDY AFTER BEING TURNED BACK ON, LET A FAUCET RUN FOR A FEW MINUTES UNTIL THE WATER CLEARS.
