Solid Waste – Fall Cleanup 2015

Copperas Cove, Texas - The Copperas Cove Solid Waste Department, Keep Copperas Cove Beautiful, and Waste Management are sponsoring a FREE Fall Cleanup event on Saturday, November 21, 2015 from 8am to 12pm at 2605 South FM 116.

The event is ONLY open to Copperas Cove residents and businesses with an active Solid Waste account (No contractors permitted). Two visits will be granted per account. Residency will be verified at the gate via utility bill and identification. Acceptable items are: household trash & junk, brush & yard waste, appliances (items containing freon must have compressor removed), recycling, tires (up to five tires total for both visits), and used cooking oil (up to 5 gallons).

Unacceptable items are: construction debris, household hazardous waste, chemicals or paint, and automotive oil or antifreeze. There are no exceptions to the above.

Items that will be accepted:

Household Trash & Junk

Brush & Yard Waste: limited to 2 pick up truck loads of brush per resident. Kraft bags only no plastic bags.


Appliances: freezers, refrigerators, and air conditioners must have compressor removed.

Recycling: scrap metal, cardboard to include cereal and soda boxes, aluminum cans, newspaper with the inserts, office paper (including magazines), steel cans, and plastics #1—#7 (No bags)

Tires: Up to five (5) passenger tires (**must be off the rim**) per household **total for both visits.**

Cooking Oil: Up to 5-gallons of cooking oil will be accepted.

- **No Construction Debris—No Exceptions**
- **No Household Hazardous Waste, Chemicals or Paint**
- **No Automotive Oil or Antifreeze**
