### **Aggravated Robbery / Terroristic Threat**

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On September 25, 2014, at 2:05 p.m. Copperas Cove Police responded to a report of an Aggravated Robbery at the Texas Partners Credit Union Bank, located at 809 S Main Street, Copperas Cove, Texas. On the same date, Copperas Cove Police responded to a report of Terroristic Threat at 400 South 25<sup>th</sup> St. (Copperas Cove High School). It was later determined that both incidents were related.

Upon arrival at the bank, Officers learned the suspect entered the bank and approached a teller. The suspect brandished a handgun and demanded money from the teller. The suspect was described as a black male, 5' 09", approximately 165-175 lbs., wearing a gray shirt, black ball cap with an unknown sports logo, black shorts, and wearing a black wig. He was last seen departing the business through the front door.

#### **Update**

As a result of the investigation conducted by the Copperas Cove Police Department, criminal complaints were filed against three suspects identified as Copperas Cove residents Jeremy Roland Emmitt 22 year old male, Kevin Shaune Gilkey 23 year old male, and Markqual Darnell Palacio 23 year old male. The suspects were arrested on January 23, 2015 and transported to the Copperas Cove Police Department without incident.

All three suspects were arraigned by Coryell County Justice of the Peace Bill Price and each received a 200,000 Surety Bond for Aggravated Robbery and 50,000 Surety Bonds for Terroristic Threat. All three suspects have since been transported to the Coryell County Jail where they remain in custody.
