Aggravated Assault

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On December 3, 2014, at approximately 8:15 AM Copperas Cove Police Officers responded to 400 South 25th St. (Copperas Cove High School) in reference to a 16 year old male student with a stab wound. The incident occurred off campus while the student was on his way to school. The student was transported to Metroplex Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.
