

Things to Remember when placing Brush and Bulk Materials out for Collection:

- Do not commingle brush with bulk or other items. The brush must be free of any other trash.
- Do not put pallets, treated lumber, or fence boards in the brush pile.
- Cut and stack all brush or place bulky and large items at the curb in front of your house at least four (4) feet away from parked vehicles, low hanging wires, limbs, fences, mailboxes, gas meters or other obstacles. The collection vehicle must have safe clearance for its crane and grapple.
- Some special provisions apply to air conditioning units, refrigerators and other items that contain refrigerants. Units containing a refrigerant must be certified by a licensed technician to be free of the refrigerant before the items can be picked up.
- Site cleanup of small debris, such as large leaves and small twigs, is the responsibility of the owner.
- Leaves and yard waste must be put in biodegradable Kraft bags or they will not be picked up.
- There is a charge of \$6.00 per cubic yard for bulk amounts over 3 cubic yards.
- There is a charge of \$6.00 per cubic yard for brush piles in excess of 8 cubic yards or 5' x 4" x 11' pile size.
