

City Facilities Update:

Just before noon on Thursday, February 11th all non-essential City of Copperas Cove facilities were closed due to the severe weather and freezing conditions brought on by Winter Storm Uri.

Many employees

continued to work, both in-person and remotely, as they were able to continue providing the best customer service possible to our residents. It has been a long and busy week but we are pleased to announce all City of Copperas Cove facilities will reopen on Monday, February 22nd for regular business hours, with this sole exception:

Solid Waste – Residential and Commercial collections will resume on a regular schedule, however the transfer station, office and scale will remain temporarily closed to the public until further notice. This action is being taken due to significant water damage from internal broken pipes. Solid Waste Administrative staff have been temporarily relocated to the Technology Center, located at 508 S. 2nd Street to remain operational. The phone lines are temporarily out of service but an update will be provided once a line is established.

Additionally:

*Municipal Court will be operational and staff will prepare and send notices to all citizens affected by the closure, for matters such as court appearance, summons, etc.

**Utility Administration will be operational and staff will evaluate all operations so we may properly update citizens on any matters affected by the prolonged closure.
