

Mountain Top Pressure Plane Update:

Seems we did good as a community since late last evening and capacities are beginning to stabilize. Mountain

Top is slowly filling and coming back online, however PLEASE continue to conserve water as you are able to help this process through so we can build pressure back up. **The ENTIRE City remains under Stage 4B Water Restrictions as previously posted until further notice.**

*Any water that is consumed on Mountain Top Pressure Plane is still under the Boil Water Notice; other areas of the City on the lower planes are not required to boil.

**Earlier this week the City made a request for bottled water through the Texas Department of Emergency Management; confirmed earlier today the request was approved and fulfilled, bottled water is heading our way. Bottled water is expected to be received very soon and moved to 5 locations to serve the residents of the Mountain Top Pressure Plane ONLY by about 330pm today. These residents have been w/out water for several days now and we need to get them served. Please see the attached area map with 4 of the 5 staging locations designated. Locations are as follows, and will be controlled by City staff and volunteers to provide 1 case of water per residence while supplies last beginning around 330pm:

Water Site 1:

VFW Parking Lot, 1506 Veterans Avenue

Water Site 2:

Veterans Avenue & Babb Street Intersection

Water Site 3:

Veterans Avenue and Freedom Lane Intersection

Water Site 4:

Freedom Lane and Buckboard Trail Intersection

Water Site 5:

Urbantke Lane and S. 23rd Street Intersection

***Fort Hood has come through with a request for support and have delivered 2 Water Buffalos. The Water Buffalos have been filled with potable water and staged at 2 locations in the Mountain Top Pressure Plane to assist residents with getting water. Please bring your own clean containers to fill:
