BOIL WATER NOTICE

Due to pressure loss from two separate main water line breaks on February 7, 2022, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required our system, (City of Copperas Cove/PWS 0500001) to notify effective customers to boil their water prior to consumption until further notice.

The affected areas are as followed:

- Ash Street
- Cedar Drive
- Yucca Drive
- Wild Plum Drive
- Margaret Lee Street
- Jessica Circle
- Table Rock Lane
- Windmill Drive
- Juniper Circle
- Bowen Circle
- Red Oak Circle
- Del Mar Circle
- Preakness Circle
- John Henry Circle
- Citation Circle
- 500, 800, & 900 Blocks of Northern Dancer Lane

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling water will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
