## **BOIL WATER NOTICE**

Due to pressure loss from a main water line break at the intersection of Wolfe Road & North Drive on March 14, 2022, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has required our system, (City of Copper Cove/PWS 0500001) to notify effective customers to boil their water prior to consumption until further notice.

**The affected areas are as followed:**

Wolfe Road  
1000 Block of North Drive

Although pressure loss was observed in the Turkey Creek Estates area as a result of this water line break, water does not have to be boiled in that area do to an alternate supply line providing water to the area.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling water will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
