

**COPPERAS COVE WATER CONSERVATION  
AND DROUGHT CONTINGENCY**

**AMENDED ORDER FOR STAGE IMPLEMENTATION**

The City of Copperas Cove was notified by the Bell County Water Control and Improvement District #1 that a major leak on the 48" transmission main occurred on May 7, 2022; and

**WHEREAS,** The transmission main was out of service for over 24 hours; and

**WHEREAS,** The City's water supply was less than the normal water use demand; and

**WHEREAS,** The City Council approved Ordinance 2019-33, amending the City's Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plan; and

**WHEREAS,** The Plan authorized the mayor to implement stages of the Plan upon determination that it was necessary to protect public health, safety, and welfare; and

**WHEREAS,** Mayor Yancey issued an Order for Stage Implementation for Stage 4B on May 7, 2022; and


**WHEREAS,** The leak has been repaired by Bell County Water Control and Improvement District #1; and

**WHEREAS,** The City of Copperas Cove was notified by Bell County Water Control and Improvement District #1 on May 8, 2022 that all electrical power was lost at the Belton Water Treatment Plant and issued a system-wide boil water notice; and

**WHEREAS,** on May 9, 2022, Bell County Water Control and Improvement District #1 has requested all customers continue to conserve water until the water system and storage reach normal operating levels.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS ORDERS** the implementation of STAGE 3 water restrictions effective on May 9, 2022. Water restrictions consistent with this stage will continue until terminated or revised by the Mayor.

**ORDERED** on this 9th day of May, 2022 as authorized by the Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plan.
