Big Divide Tornado: Preliminary Disaster Assessment Findings

On Monday June 17, 2019 representatives from the Building Officials Association of Texas (BOAT) Disaster Response Team conducted a preliminary damage assessment of properties located within the area near Big Divide where an EF-02 Tornado struck on Sunday June 9, 2019 at about 5:30 PM.

The officials then provided an assessment of their findings which revealed that homes affected by the storm were found to be situated in either Coryell County or Lampasas County but within the City Limits of Copperas Cove. The total damage assessment of homes that were evaluated is estimated to be **\$2,680,875** in that area. The breakdown by county is **Coryell** \$2,459,206.25 and **Lampasas** is \$221,228.75.

These findings are subject to change if further information is received and are illustrative numbers that are only an estimation of the damages. Information that a property owner may receive from their insurance company will prevail in all circumstances.

The preliminary disaster assessment that was completed does **NOT** promise or guarantee that any reimbursement funding will be made available. The assessment findings will be reported to the State of Texas so that a record of the local damages may be noted and added to statewide disaster damage numbers.
