SW Brush/Bulk Fees Waived for Certain Residences

Copperas Cove, Texas – On June 11, 2019 Mayor Bradi Diaz issued a Disaster Declaration for the area of the City of Copperas Cove that was affected by the EF-02 Tornado that struck on June 9th in the western portion of Copperas Cove near and adjacent to Big Divide Road.

All citizens are encouraged to review the attached map for the affected area, as highlighted in yellow. To assist with clean-up efforts, Solid Waste has made it a priority to conduct collections in this area. Citizens in the affected area are encouraged to place all brush and bulk debris curbside, in separated piles and not on the street, for complimentary collection. Collection fees will be WAIVED thru next Monday, June 17th, for all affected residences. Solid Waste will resume with the normal collection schedule on June 18th. Please keep in mind, any contractors hired to complete work are required by City Ordinance to arrange for their own collection of debris.
