### **Library Summer Reading Program**

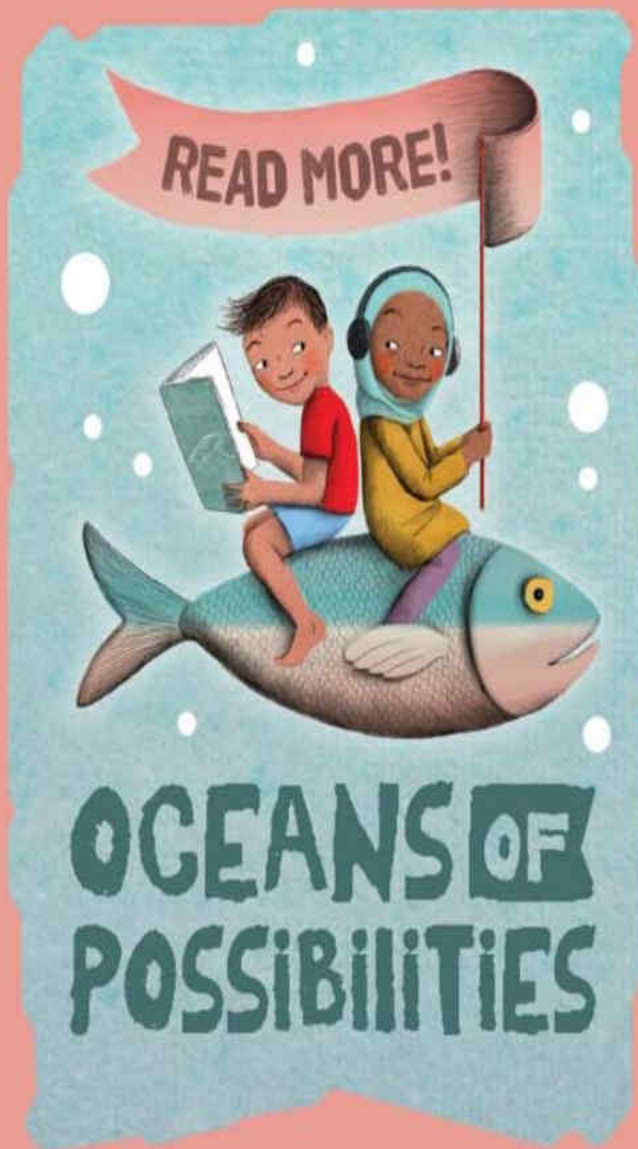

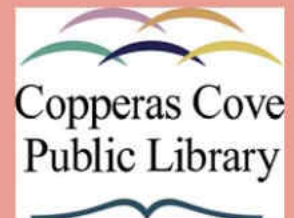
