ORDER RESTRICTING OUTDOOR BURNING  
**WITHOUT EXCEPTION**

WHEREAS, the Lampasas County Commissioners' Court has determined that circumstances present in the unincorporated areas of the County created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning, and under the authority of Section 352.081 of the Texas Local Government Code:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Lampasas County Commissioners Court that all outdoor burning is banned in the unincorporated areas of the County for 90 days commencing at immediately on August 11, 2021 and ending on November 8, 2021, unless the restrictions are terminated based on a determination made by this Court. There are NO exceptions to this order other than those specifically granted by State law allowing for outdoor burning related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for: 1) firefighter training, 2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations, or 3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops OR Burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048 of the Natural Resources Code and meeting the requirements of the standards of 153.047 of the Natural Resources Code.

In Accordance with Local Government Code Section 352.081, a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor and punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00
