Robertson Avenue Mill and Overlay Project Update

Copperas Cove, Texas – The Robertson Avenue Mill and Overlay Project will begin on Monday, August 31, 2020 and work is expected to last through Thursday, September 3, 2020. During this time Lone Star Paving will be resurfacing Robertson Avenue from S. Main Street to Mueller Street, milling 1” of old asphalt and overlaying with a new layer of asphalt. The bid contract was awarded by City Council on July 7, 2020 in the amount of \$243,050.65.

The attached notice was distributed to all affected residents last week, requesting that all vehicles, trailers and similar obstructions are removed from the street during this scheduled project period from 7am to 7pm. Solid Waste collections will continue as scheduled, however residents along Robertson Avenue are asked to keep all items out of the street and on top of the curb until work is completed.

All motorists are encouraged to follow posted road construction signs for the safety of themselves and work crews.
