Safety Improvement, Pedestrian and Bicyclist Mobility and Access — BUS 190 — Coyrell County

November 19, 2020

WACO – Beginning Monday, November 30, crews will begin TxDOT’s project on BUS 190 to construct a raised median, bike lane, and sidewalk on the south side of the road. Additionally, crews will convert the north outside lane to a shared vehicle and bicycle lane to retain three travel lanes in each direction.

The span of the project runs from FM 1113 (Avenue D) to Constitution Drive. During the project, traffic control will be administered in several different phases. The eastbound outside lane will be closed for the sidewalk work. Once the outside lane is reopened, the left turn lane and the inside lane on each side of the left turn lane will be closed for the median construction. Once the median construction is completed and the inside lanes are reopened, there will be various lane closures to install the final surface of the roadway.

The entire project is scheduled to be complete in summer of 2022.

The 1.3-mile project is being undertaken by TTG Utilities at a cost of approximately 4.8 million-dollars.

TxDOT urges all motorists to use caution, watch for construction personnel and equipment, and to slow their speed approaching work zones.
