Copperas Cove, Texas – The Copperas Cove Solid Waste Department and Keep Copperas Cove Beautiful will host the annual City Wide Fall Clean-Up and B.O.P.A. (Batteries, Oil, Paint, Antifreeze) event on Saturday, November 21, 2020 from 8am to 12pm. During this event, Copperas Cove residents and business owners will be granted two FREE visits per utility account to Solid Waste, located at 2605 South FM 116, to dispose of household trash and waste. Participants will be required to show current proof of residency.

Items that will be accepted are basic household trash and junk, brush and yard waste, appliances, recycling, cooking oil, tires, and B.O.P.A (Batteries, Oil, Paint, Antifreeze). Construction debris and other various household hazardous waste items will NOT be accepted during this event. Please review the attached flyers for additional specific information.

Household Trash & Junk

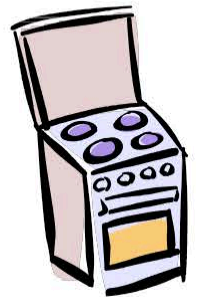
Brush & Yard Waste: limited to 2 pickup truck loads of brush per resident. Yard waste in Kraft bags only no plastic bags. No trailer loads.

Appliances: freezers, refrigerators, and air conditioners must have the compressor removed.

Computers: including monitors, computer towers (CPU's), keyboard, mice and printers will be accepted.

Recycling: scrap metal, cardboard to include cereal and soda boxes, aluminum cans, newspaper with the inserts, office paper (including magazines), steel cans, and plastics #1-#7. No plastic bags!

Cooking Oil: Cooking oil will be accepted. Cooking oil must be verified by Solid Waste personnel.



****No Construction Debris—No Exceptions**

Don't pour cooking oil down the drain, bring it to us and have it recycled!

TIRES: 2EA FREE TIRES WITHOUT RIMS WILL BE ALLOWED PER-HOUSEHOLD – ANY MORE WILL BE CHARGED AT THE REGULAR PRICE OF \$3 PER TIRE FOR 17" AND BELOW, OR \$7 PER TIRE FOR 17.5" AND ABOVE. AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF \$20 APPLIES IF RIMS ARE LEFT ON THE TIRE.
