Burglary Suspects Arrested

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On February 7, 2024 at approximately 3:54 AM, Copperas Cove Police Officers were dispatched to 307 Judy Lane, Willow Creek Apartments, in reference to a report of a vehicle burglary in progress.

Upon arrival, officers gathered information from witnesses who observed a male subject burglarizing a vehicle before fleeing in a white sedan. Further investigation revealed there was more than one suspect involved. While officers canvassed the area, they located a white sedan parked nearby and found it occupied with a female subject who was eventually identified as one of the suspects.

During the investigation, officers received additional reports of vehicle burglaries and a theft of a motor vehicle. Officers pursued investigative leads, which led them to a nearby residence where they apprehended a male subject who was identified as the second suspect. A subsequent search yielded recovered stolen property reported from the vehicle burglaries. The stolen vehicle was also recovered and returned to the registered owner.

The suspects were identified as 17-year-old, Shania April Mackay Des Hawkins, and 18-year-old, Allias Dupri King, both residents of Copperas Cove. Both suspects were taken into custody without incident, and were each charged with ten counts of Burglary of a Vehicle, Theft \$2500-\$30,000 for the motor vehicle theft, and other misdemeanor charges.

On February 8, 2024, Shania April Mackay Des Hawkins and Allias Dupri King, were arraigned by Coryell County Justice of the Peace F.W. "Bill" Price and each received a total bond of \$49,000. The Copperas Cove Police Department continues to investigate this incident.
