Burglary Suspects Arrested

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On February 21, 2022 at approximately 2:30 AM, Copperas Cove Police Officers were dispatched to the 400 block of E Ave D in reference to a business alarm. Upon arrival, officers discovered several businesses had been burglarized. As officers were canvassing the area, they located a vehicle in a nearby parking lot with two occupants inside.

During the investigation, officers conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and discovered items stolen from the burglaries. The two suspects admitted to their involvement in the burglaries. They were identified as James Darell Lincoln and Isaac John Allan, both residents of Copperas Cove. Both suspects were taken into custody without incident, and were each charged with four counts of Burglary of a Building.

On February 22, 2022, James Darell Lincoln and Isaac John Allan were arraigned by Justice of the Peace John Guinn and each received a total bond of \$40,000, \$10,000 per charge. The Copperas Cove Police Department continues to investigate this incident.
