Death Investigation

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On April 7, 2022 at approximately 12:25 PM, officers were dispatched to 1000 block of Hobby Road in reference to a 9-1-1 hang up call for service. The responding officer discovered a male and female, both of whom appeared to have sustained gunshot wounds. The male was transported to Darnall Army Medical Center by Copperas Cove EMS and is in stable condition. The female succumbed to her wounds on scene. The names of the involved parties are being withheld, pending notification of next of kin.

Members of the Copperas Cove Police Department Criminal Investigations Section continue to investigate the incident. Additional information will be provided at a later time.

UPDATE

April 8, 2022

The female has been identified as 33-year old Destiney Jassmund Carey of Copperas Cove. Destiney was pronounced deceased at the scene by Justice of the Peace Bill Price. The male was identified as 37-year old Kevin Frazier of Copperas Cove. Kevin remains hospitalized as of the release of this update.

The case continues to be investigated by the Copperas Cove Police Department Criminal Investigations Section.

UPDATE #2

April 11, 2022

On April 9, 2022, the investigation led detectives to file criminal complaints against Kevin Frazier. The complaints were presented to Justice of the Peace Bill Price, who subsequently issued two arrest warrants charging Kevin with Murder and Aggravated Assault Against Public Servant. Kevin was taken into custody by Fort Hood military police the same day without incident. Kevin was later transported to the Coryell County jail and arraigned by Justice of the Peace Jim Caldwell on April 11, 2022. Justice of the Peace Caldwell set his bond at \$1,000,000 for the murder charge and \$750,000 for the aggravated assault charge.
