Aggravated Assault with Deadly Weapon

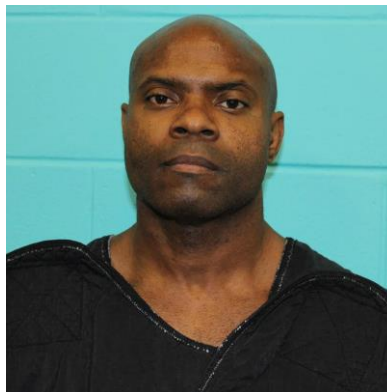
COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On April 19, 2024, at approximately 3:28 PM, Copperas Cove Police Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 2100 block of Liberty Street in response to reports of shots fired. Upon arrival, officers found witnesses who reported seeing a male firing several shots at a residence before fleeing the scene in a black sedan.

The responding officers established contact with the occupant of the targeted residence, who was confirmed to be alone at the time of the incident and uninjured. Their investigation revealed several rounds had penetrated the residence. The suspect, known to the occupant, was positively identified. There were no injuries or property damage beyond the initial incident.

Despite extensive efforts, the suspect was unable to be located within the city limits. Preliminary information about the suspect, the offense, and his vehicle was shared with surrounding agencies to aid in his apprehension. Our telecommunicators played a crucial role in maintaining constant communication with law enforcement agencies, facilitating timely updates, and ultimately aiding in the timely apprehension of the suspect.

Troopers with the Texas Department of Public Safety in Nolan County, Texas, located the suspect's vehicle and apprehended him without further incident. The suspect, identified as 40-year-old Copperas Cove resident Jiren Rodgers-Di'sonni, is currently in custody at Nolan County Jail, charged with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon.

On April 20, 2024, Jiren Rodgers-Di'sonni was arraigned at Nolan County Jail, and his bond was set at \$20,000. The Copperas Cove Police Department continues to investigate this incident.
