### Intoxication Manslaughter

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – Copperas Cove Police are investigating a fatality traffic collision which occurred during the evening hours of July 27, 2019.

At approximately 6:42 PM, Copperas Cove Police and Fire Departments responded to the 200 block of W Business Highway 190 regarding a two-vehicle collision. Upon arrival officers made contact with one of the drivers, Robert Bikoski, who was not breathing. Officers and EMS personnel performed life saving measures on Robert but he succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased by Coryell County Justice of the Peace John Guinn.

Witnesses on scene told responding officers that the driver of the other vehicle had fled the scene. A short time later the driver was seen by one of the witnesses crossing the street. Officers quickly caught up to the suspect who was identified as Daniel Christopher Burcham. Daniel's speech was slurred and he appeared to be under the influence of intoxicants. Daniel was subsequently arrested and transported to the Copperas Cove Jail.

Daniel was charged with Intoxication Manslaughter. Daniel was arraigned by Coryell County Justice of the Peace Bill Price and his bond was set at \$100,000. The Copperas Cove Police Department is continuing to investigate this incident.
