Deadly Conduct - Discharge Firearm

COPPERAS COVE, TEXAS – On October 18th, 2022, at approximately 5:37 P.M., Copperas Cove Police Officers responded to 2990 East Business Highway 190 for shots fired.

Officers arrived on scene and observed a damaged window on the front of the building, and located a bullet fragment. Witnesses on scene reported hearing a gunshot. Detectives responded to investigate and as a result of their investigation, they identified a suspect and obtained an arrest warrant for Deadly Conduct-Discharge Firearm.

The suspect was identified as 27-year-old, Copperas Cove resident, Clay Mitchell McCumber. On October 19th, 2022, McCumber was taken into custody.

Further investigation revealed McCumber's involvement in a separate incident on October 8, 2022, in which officers responded to 2990 E Business Highway 190 for shots fired. This incident also resulted in property damage. There were no injuries in either incident. McCumber was charged with a second count of Deadly Conduct-Discharge Firearm.

On October 20th, 2022, Clay Mitchell McCumber was arraigned by Justice of the Peace John Guinn and received a total bond of \$75,000. The Criminal Investigation Division continues to investigate this incident.
