Why Should I Recycle My Used Cooking Oil?

- The City of Copperas Cove has incurred significant operational and maintenance costs associated with Fats, Oils and Grease (FOG) .
- Improper disposal of cooking oil not only affects our city financially, but also **you**, the resident.
- Disposing of used cooking oil in an improper way, may cause clogged and broken pipes that can cost thousands of dollars to repair.

Central Texas College Enactus partnered with The City of Copperas Cove to help residents recycle their used cooking oil FREE through one central location

- HOW:**
- Let the used cooking oil or grease cool to a safe handling temperature.
 - Once cooled, pour the used cooking oil into a jar or bottle with a lid.
 - Take the oil to the Copperas Cove Solid Waste Department.
 - Carefully pour the used cooking oil into the used cooking oil tank.
 - Recycle the oil container, or reuse it next time you fry.
